

## QT Devotional Journal Sample Guide

**Bible Passage:** Psalm 23

**Date:** 8/1/20xx

**Title:** (Use 2-10 words for the title of this passage.) *My Good Shepherd*

### ❖ **How is God portrayed in this passage?**

(Listen and think carefully what kind of God He is: His thoughts, acts, emotions and character.)

*A provider, promise keeper, omniscient, almighty*

### ❖ **The truths, promises, teachings and instructions I received today:**

(What promises, exhortation, commands, or convictions does this passage give me?)

*Don't be scared of being poor. He loves me, provides for me (vs.1), comforts me, be with me (vs.4), fights for me (vs.5).*

### ❖ **How can I apply this to my daily life?**

(Examine and apply it to myself. Practically apply this passage will change my life.)

*I'll give You my need in my job and personal finance*

*Declare everyday: For the Lord is my shepherd, my provider, I shall not be in want financially*

### ❖ **Listen to God**

(Come with a simple heart. Believe that God desires and will surely talk to me today! Spend some quiet time, or practice waiting upon the Lord (you may play some soft music). Receive any thoughts, comfort, edification or advice from Him.)

*My child, be a little lamb who follows me closely, desires to come near the quiet waters, listen to me talking to you*

### ❖ **Thanksgiving and Prayer**

(Give Him thanks for the revelation, promise, teaching or application He gave you, and offer Him thanksgiving and commitment in your prayer.)

*Lord, you know I am fearful about the future. And I am worried about the situation of my company, wondering if my job would last. Thank you for telling me you are a good shepherd. I want to be your little lamb, follow you to the green pastures and the quiet waters. Open my ears, let me hear your voice everyday, and gain hope and strength. Amen!*
